

SUPPLEMENTAL STATEMENT FROM BARBARA TOWNSLEY

September 10, YR-0

At the request of my attorney, I am clarifying four things in my statement.

1. Nick and I are now divorced. I have left Middleway House and live in an apartment but I will not disclose the address because I am still afraid of Nick. My bail bond was paid by an anonymous person.

2. The money I inherited from my grandmother that Nick took has been returned to me. It is \$450,000.

3. In my statement, I did not say anything about the events of July 4th. I understand that others are alleging that I caused a disturbance at a party at Tina Moran's apartment. That was a very emotional time for me because my husband was abandoning me and I have no memory of anything that happened that day. I think I would remember going to a party, so as far as I know, I did not do so. I would point out that I did not have access to a car.

4. When I was married to Nick, he gave me an ATM card so I could withdraw money for groceries and other household items. Nick put the money into the account and when I would check the balance, there was never more than \$300 in it. Because he would get mad sometimes and take the money out of the account, I had hidden small amounts around the house over the years in case I needed it. When I bought the gun, I used the cash I had been saving and did not pay with the ATM card because Nick would see the bank statement.
