Re: FINAL TRIALS

Final trials will be conducted Sunday November 27 through Saturday December 3. Each student will be randomly assigned to be a plaintiff or defense attorney. There will generally be two attorneys assigned to each side. Each attorney will prepare and conduct a direct examination and a cross-examination. Each student will also prepare both an opening statement and a closing argument, but you will not perform both. At the start of the trial, you will be assigned to perform one or the other. Although there will generally be two attorneys per side, that does not mean you work as partners. This is a final exam, and each attorney must do his or her own work. You are not supposed to consult with or work with other students. No part of your grade is based on anything your teammate does.

In order to assign you to a side and a time slot, I need to know **when** you are available to try the case. Please print the form on the next page, fill it out, and return it to me.
