

PROBLEM 21.

In *Turner v. Big Red*, the plaintiff has six exhibits:

- (1) a photograph of the scene of the accident,
- (2) the police report containing a statement from a bystander describing the accident,
- (3) a computer print-out of the hospital emergency room report,
- (4) the actual mangled wheelchair Turner had been sitting in when struck,
- (5) the cell phone recovered in the front seat of the truck and allegedly being used by the driver, which was damaged in the crash so that it is not possible to retrieve any data on it.
- (6) a video recording from a courthouse security camera showing the accident taking place.

Think through for each exhibit how you would authenticate them, including whom you would call and what kinds of questions you would ask.
